2. Do the Taste Test


Have students taste the peppers and write down their observation using the *Rate the Taste* chart and *Appendix 1: Adjectives* (10 min)

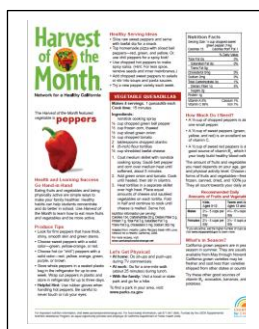
